

Anglophone World – Political and Economic Geography

The course in Political and Economic Geography of the Anglophone World introduces students to the basic political and economic reality in various territorial zones. The course is explained on the basis of physio-geographical assumptions; demographic changes; political, economic, and cultural connections; and of the historical dispersal of the current political structure and spread of economic potential in Anglophone regions. The course provides students with foundations for understanding macroeconomic as well as political reality both in global as well as regional contexts. The course aims to clarify both dimensional (spatial) organisation of socio-economic systems and information on changes in the political maps of Anglophone regions due to the influence of geographic environment, character of population and political concepts.

The structure of the course encourages discussion on current issues of Anglosphere.
