

## **Specific Terminology of the Study Programme**

The aim of this course is to make learners familiar with the language of authentic news reports, texts and articles related to various topics relevant to the area of English-speaking countries (e.g. society, politics and governments, public administration, education, EU, gender issues, multiculturalism and culture). This course expands learners' vocabulary so that they do not lack specialised vocabulary when dealing with the topics related to the area of English-speaking countries. The course encourages learners to use complex structures and appropriate extent of contributions in order to sustain dynamic development of the discourse; and lastly motivates learners to participate competently in the range of interactive situations.

The course is taught interactively and learners are expected to participate in group discussions and individual presentations. Learners are also expected to accomplish practical tasks such as making drafts, notes, and translating EU authentic documents in order to be ready for work in public administration, EU bodies, etc.
