

## **Rector's Directive No. 5/2008**

### **Admission of students and graduates from colleges of further education (VOŠ)**

The Rector of Metropolitan University Prague, o.p.s., (MUP), is entitled to admit a student or a graduate from a college of further education (VOŠ) to a shortened study programme at MUP under the following general conditions:

1. The VOŠ student / graduate may only be admitted to a Bachelors Degree study programme in a specialisation equivalent or similar to the field of study of the VOŠ that s/he had studied at / graduated from.
2. The VOŠ student / graduate submits an application to studies at MUP, completes an application for admission to a relevant year of study and an application for equivalent assessment recognition. For assessment recognition, rules stipulated by Rector's Directive No. 3/2008 from 25 February 2008 apply.
3. The documents presented by the applicant are considered by the Prorector for Education together with the Head of the relevant department. The Head of Department then suggests the year of study to which the VOŠ student / graduate should be admitted with regard to the number of courses recognized and the number of assessments yet to be completed.
4. The statement of the Prorector for Education must then be presented to the Rector who decides whether or not to admit the VOŠ student / graduate to a shortened study programme at MUP.
5. The VOŠ student / graduate admitted to a shortened study programme at MUP must, during the course of his/her studies, complete all study requirements from previous semesters that were not recognized or for the recognition of which s/he did not apply.
6. MUP is entitled to agree upon individual admission conditions and study organisation with VOŠ graduates.

This directive comes into force on 3 March 2008.
